Badruddoza, Executive Vice-Chairman, Bangladesh Agril. Research Council & Chairman of the Technical Committee, National Seed Board in his office chamber.

Agendum-1 : Confirmation of the minutes of the last (9th) meeting of the Technical Committee held on 30-6-83.

In opening up of the discussion it was confirmed that all the actions on the decisions of the last (9th) meeting of the Technical Committee, National Seed Board have been taken.

Agendum -II : Release of guava variety, Kazi PIARA-I evolved by Citrus and Vegetable Seed Research Centre, B.A.R.I.

With the permission of the chair, the Member-Secretary informed the house that B.A.R.I. has submitted the application for the release of the gava variety, Kazi PIARA -I. In short he explained the important characteristics of the variety Kazi PIARA-I. Next he invited all the members and special invitee to take part on the discussion for the possible release of the variety. All the members participated on the discussion. Mr, Abdur Razzaque, P.S.O & Head, Citrus & Vegetable Seed Research Centre, B.A.R.I. on request of Member-Secretary gave an outline on the salient features & characteristics of the variety. In doing so, he informed the house that the fruit of this new guava variety is quite big and with few soft seeds and crispy taste. He further mentioned that no serious pests and diseases were noticed in the variety. At this stage, one of the members pointed out no clear information was furnished as to the planting time of the variety. On this issue, Chairman, T.C suggested that this information and other agronomic information could be supplied by Citrus & Vegetable Seed Research Centre, B.A.R.I. in the form of a literature for the crop which would be useful for the Directorate of Agril. Extension (F.S.D) for the purpose of doing extension work with the crop variety. All members supported this view of the Chairman. During this discussion, member-Secretary apprised the members of the house that the performance of the variety in question has been evaluated by the Evaluation Team. The report of the Team indicates that this is a very good guava variety in comparison with the indigenous one & was in favor of

recommending the variety for its release. At the end, all the members present unanimously agreed that this variety might be recommended for its final release.

Decisions : 1. The guava variety, Kazi PIARA-I is recommended for final release.

1. A literature on this guava variety be prepared by Citrus and Vegetables Seed Research centre, B.A.R.I for the use of the Department of Agril. Extension (F.S.D)

Agendum- III : Release of two vegetable varieties Gikur sak (Kuroba) & Sai Sak (Saishin) evolved by Citrus & Vegetable Seed Research Centre, BARI.

The applications for the release of two vegetable varieties- Gikur Sak and Sai Sak along with the evaluation report were discussed in the meeting by the members present. All the members discussed thoroughly on the performance of these two leafy vegetable varieties. It is understood that the Team Leader, Evaluation Team visited the vegetable plots with his team members and observed the good performance of the crops and gave their views for the release of the two vegetable varieties. At this stage, few members raised objection on the proposed popular name of the varieties as "Gikur Sak" & "Sai Sak". Other members joined hands with them and said that they also did not like these popular names. Chairman, Technical Committee at this point suggested that B.A.R.I should submit new names of the varieties and send their proposal to the Member-Secretary, Technical Committee within a week and thereafter a meeting be held in the office chamber of Dr. M.S. Ahmed, Associate director, B.R.R.I for taking a decision on the proposed new popular names of the vegetables varieties. The house supported the suggestive views of the Chairman, Technical Committee. The house further gave their consent as to the recommendation for the final release of these two leafy vegetable varieties.

Decisions : 1. New popular name for the two vegetable varieties be proposed and sent to Member-Secretary, Technical Committee.

2. A meeting be held in the room of the Associate Director B.R.R.I. for taking a decision on the proposal for new names of the vegetable varieties.

3. Both the vegetable varieties are recommended for final release subject to the availability of the new popular names of the varieties.

Agendum – IV : Selection of a temporary Team Leader, Evaluation Team of Technical Committee, National Seed Board.

Member-Secretary of the Technical Committee informed the house that the present Team Leader, Mr. A.K.M. Anwarul Kibria, Joint Director of Agril. Extension (F.S.D.) has left the country for about three months. It is expected that he will come back in country in the last week of November/1983. So, a Team Leader may be selected on temporary basis for the smooth functioning of the Technical Committee. Chairman & Member-Secretary, T.C suggested that among the senior team members, Dr. Sharfat H. Khan, Principal, College of Agril. Sciences, Shalna, Dhaka may be selected as Team Leader, Evaluation Team on temporary basis. The suggestion was accepted by the house.

Decision : Dr. Sharfat H. Khan, Principal, College of Agril. Sciences, Shalna, Dhaka be selected as Team Leader, E.T. on temporary basis.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.
